





# NCEA levels and certificates

There are three levels of NCEA certificate available at school.  
Credits (points) can be gained over more than one year.

<b>Level 1</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 80 credits are required at any level (level 1, 2 or 3)</li><li>• literacy and numeracy</li></ul>
<b>Level 2</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 60 credits at level 2 (or 3)</li><li>• + 20 credits from any level (level 1, 2 or 3)</li><li>• Level 1 literacy and numeracy</li></ul>
<b>Level 3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 60 credits at level 3</li><li>• + 20 credits from level 2 (or 3)</li><li>• Level 1 literacy and numeracy</li></ul>

# Level 1 Literacy & Numeracy

## ***Literacy***

- 10 credits literacy from specified list
- demonstrate reading, writing, speaking and listening skills

## ***Numeracy***


- 10 credits numeracy from specified list
- demonstrate number, measurement and statistical skills.

Literacy and Numeracy credits are available in a range of courses, not just English and Maths.

# Courses

- Yr 11 course typically offer 18 – 20 credits
- A course is made of topics (standards) that are worth credits (typically 3-6 credits depending on the standard)
- Unit Standards (US)  
possible grades = Not Achieved or Achieved
- Achievement Standards (AS)  
possible grades = Not Achieved, Achieved, Merit or Excellence
- A student doesn't get more credits for a higher grade.

# Certificate Endorsement

For an NCEA certificate to be endorsed a student must gain 50 credits at Merit or Excellence at the level of the certificate or above.

50 Level 2 credits at Excellence = Level 2 certificate endorsed with Excellence.

50 credits at Merit (or Merit and Excellence) at Level 2 = Level 2 certificate endorsed with Merit.

Endorsement awards show on a student's Record of Achievement that is available on the NZQA website.

# Course Endorsement

Course endorsement provides recognition for a student who has performed exceptionally well in an individual course eg. Mathematics endorsed with Excellence at Level 1

Students will gain an endorsement for a course if, in a single school year, they achieve:

14 or more credits at Merit or Excellence, and at least 3 of these credits from externals (exams/ folios) and 3 credits from internals (during school year assessments).

A course endorsement is not a qualification.
