Senior Derived Grade Exams 2017

Please check the timetable carefully to see when your exams are on. Some students will have a clash – if this applies to you then you need to see Mr Rout as soon as possible.

During the exams students are only required to be at school if they have an exam. Year 11 and 12 students are to wear correct school uniform.

Details of start times and rooms will be provided nearer the time. All afternoon exams will finish by the end of school so students can catch buses.

You may not leave any exam in the first 45 minutes or the last 15 minutes. If you finish during either of those times you are to sit silently. Doing other work or listening to music is not permitted. This also applies to the end of year external exams.

Students with special assessment conditions will be contacted separately.

For each exam make sure you bring all the equipment you need including spare pens. Bags are to be left at the front of the room. Cellphones must be turned off and not kept in pockets. Critical items such as cellphones and keys can be kept in a clear plastic bag on the floor under your desk in case of emergency evacuation. Cellphones cannot be used in any way during an exam – not even to check the time. All paper for writing answers will be supplied for you – you do not need your own.

Important

Students who are unable to sit an exam may be able to do a catch-up during the exam period. This will only happen if the reason for missing the exam is sickness or exceptional circumstances. Exceptional circumstances could include attending a national sporting competition or be the result of a family bereavement.

If a student is unable to attend an exam Mr Rout should be informed as soon as possible.
