

2022 Year 11 Diploma Criteria

To gain a Lincoln High School Year 11 Diploma, a student needs to meet all of the following criteria:

1. Obtain an overall average attendance rate of 95% or more, for all 2022 timetabled periods including the Linc periods.
2. Obtain an overall 70% academic success rate that includes all 2022
 - Non- NCEA assessments
 - Effort and Work Completion report grades
 - NCEA assessments.
3. Complete Level 1 literacy and numeracy.

Notes:

- a) The following grades count towards a students' academic success rate:
 - Non-NCEA topics – Working within, above and well above the expected level
 - NCEA topics - Achieved, Merit and Excellence
 - Effort and Work Completion report grades range from:
Unsatisfactory (1), Inconsistent (2), Good (3), Very Good (4), Excellent (5)

Please see note h) for an example of a success rate calculation.

- b) If a student gains a Year 11 and Year 12 diploma, they are eligible to gain a Graduation diploma with distinction in Year 13.
- c) Year 11 Linc teachers will monitor students' progress and provide them with updated Year 11 diploma results.
- d) Due to exceptional circumstances, a student that has not met all of the criteria may be eligible for Principal discretionary consideration.

- e) The attendance rate is based on the periods attended or that have justified absences (e.g. medical absences or appointments, school events and trips etc). Absences that reduce the diploma attendance rate include unexplained absences, truancy, holidays during term time and unjustified absences in accordance with the Ministry of Education requirements.
- f) The Year 11 diplomas will be presented at the Year 11 awards ceremony on Wednesday, 30th November.
- g) Involvement in a significant behavioural issue may result in a student not being invited to the Year 11 awards ceremony.
- h) Example of an Academic Success Rate calculation

Types of Grades	Score	Maximum Points Possible	Diploma Points Earned
1) Overall Effort & Work Completion <u>average</u> from reports	4.0 (Effort) & 4.4 (Work comp.) = average 4.2 out of 5 = 84%	30	84% of 30 = 25.2
2) *Non- NCEA Assessments	28 out of 36 passed = 78%	40	78% of 40 = 31.1
3) NCEA Assessments Credits	15 out of 18 credits = 83%	30	83% of 30 = 25.0
Total			81.3 % Academic Success Rate

*Non – NCEA assessment grades are reported at the end of Semester 1 and 2.
