This is a multi level course with a variety of Level 2 and 3 NCEA standards on offer.

For Level 2 NCEA students there are 20 University Entrance literacy credits that come from standards 91980, 91981, 91982 and 91983.

For Level 3 students, this is a University Entrance (UE) approved subject as it meets NZQA's UE subject criteria. It includes a total of 20 UE approved credits that come from standards associated with Te Ao Haka, a UE approved subject. The standards that make this up are 91984, 91985, 91986 and 91987.
