


NCEA levels and certificates

There are three levels of NCEA certificate available at school. Credits (points) can be gained over more than one year.

 80 credits are required at any level (level 1, 2 or 3) literacy and numeracy
 60 credits at level 2 (or 3) + 20 credits from any level (level 1, 2 or 3) Level 1 literacy and numeracy
 60 credits at level 3 + 20 credits from level 2 (or 3) Level 1 literacy and numeracy

Level 1 Literacy & Numeracy

Literacy

- 10 credits literacy from specified list
- demonstrate reading, writing, speaking and listening skills

Numeracy

- 10 credits numeracy from specified list
- demonstrate number, measurement and statistical skills.

Literacy and Numeracy credits are available in a range of courses, not just English and Maths.

Carry over credits

- The <u>first</u> 20 Level 1 credits that are gained in Yr 11 are carried over to Level 2. This means students need to gain **60** Level 2 credits in Yr 12 to gain NCEA level 2.

- The <u>first</u> 20 Level 2 credits that are gained in Yr 12 are carried over to Level 3. This means students need to gain **60** Level 3 credits in Yr 13 to gain NCEA level 3.



- Yr 12 course typically offers 16 18 credits Yr 13 course typically offer 18 – 20 credits
- A course is made of topics (standards) that are worth credits (typically 3-6 credits depending on the standard)
- <u>Unit Standards (</u>US)

possible grades = Not Achieved or Achieved

Achievement Standards (AS)

possible grades = Not Achieved, Achieved, Merit or Excellence


- A student doesn't get more credits for a higher grade.

50 Level 2 credits at Excellence = <u>Level 2 certificate endorsed with</u> <u>Excellence.</u>

50 credits at Merit (or Merit and Excellence) at Level 2 = <u>Level 2 certificate</u> <u>endorsed with Merit.</u>

Course Endorsement

<u>14 or more credits at Merit or Excellence</u>, and at least <u>3 of these credits from</u> <u>externals (exams/ folios) and <u>3 credits from internals</u> (during school year assessments).</u>

A course endorsement is not a qualification.

University Entrance (UE) is the minimum requirement to go to a NZ university. To qualify you will need:

- 1) NCEA Level 3
- 2) 14 credits in three different UE approved subjects at Level 3
- 3) UE Literacy 10 credits at <u>Level 2 or above</u>
 5 credits in <u>reading</u> & 5 credits in <u>writing</u> from the approved list
- 4) UE Numeracy 10 credits at Level 1 or above,

University Entrance will appear on the Record of Achievement.
