Why Lincoln?

What is special about Lincoln High School?

The student-centred curriculum is responsive to students' needs and interests.

Wide choice of courses – 20 options at Year 9, 37 options at Year 10, 94 course options at Year 11, 61 at Year 12 and 65 course options at Year 13.

We are a Positive Behaviour for Learning school. Our tikanga guides how all of us, young people and adults, behave and treat each other.
