

International Group Policy

Rationale:

Lincoln High School is committed to providing a quality programme that ensures the safety, wellbeing and the quality of social education of all International Student Groups studying at the school.

International Groups may be:

- Two or more students holding a group visa supplied by NZIS and studying for no more than three months on a visit organised by Lincoln High School
- A group of students on individual visas, studying together for no more than three months on a visit organised by Lincoln High School

Guidelines:

- 1. To promote international understanding and enhance the multi-cultural dimension of our school
- 2. To provide a supportive atmosphere both in the home and learning environment
- 3. To provide quality education and service including pastoral care and extra-curricular experiences reflecting this community and its environment
- 4. To ensure the enrolment system and pastoral care meets the requirements of the Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice for 2016
- 5. To ensure provision of economic support for the school and its community
