

## **International Student Policy**

## **Rationale:**

Lincoln High School is committed to providing a quality programme that ensures the safety, wellbeing and academic success for all International Students studying at the school.

**International Student** at any time, means a person who is not then a domestic student. Although deemed domestic, exchange students, students whose parents may be studying a PHD or on a work visa, and permanent residents who have recently arrived in this country, and whose level of English means they are not able to work independently in a classroom situation, may come under the umbrella of the International Department.

## **Guidelines:**

- **1.** To promote international understanding and enhance the multi-cultural dimension of our school
- **2.** To provide a supportive atmosphere and environment for international students both in the learning environment and the home situation
- **3.** To provide quality education for international students with extra support, as appropriate, to enable them to achieve maximum academic success
- **4.** To ensure the enrolment system is suitable to the needs of Lincoln High School and international students
- 5. To develop appropriate staffing practices to cater for international students
- 6. To provide firm guidelines on matters of pastoral care for international students
- 7. To ensure provision of economic support for the school and its community
- 8. To recruit students actively by promoting Lincoln High School on the international market
- **9.** To meet with the NZQA's Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice 2016 requirements.
