



International Students: Accommodation Policy

Rationale:

Lincoln High School undertakes to provide a suitable living environment conducive to study and a safe and supportive home life.

Guidelines:

1. To comply with the accommodation provisions set out in Education (Pastoral Care for International Students) Code of Practice 2016.
2. The categories of accommodation that will be accepted by the school are: Living with a parent; a designated caregiver; homestay or temporary accommodation for groups students and short courses only
3. To involve the residential carer in the welfare of a student away from the student's family and home country.
4. To assist the student to successfully integrate into the New Zealand lifestyle.
5. To work towards the overseas parents' peace of mind knowing that the student is well cared for and happy in New Zealand.
