



International Students: Accommodation Policy

Rationale:

The purpose of this policy is to provide information and guidance to all to ensure that Lincoln High School undertakes to provide a suitable living environment conducive to study and a safe and supportive home life.

Guidelines:

- To comply with the accommodation provisions set out in Education (Pastoral Care for International Students) Code of Practice 2021.
- The categories of accommodation that will be accepted by the school are: Living with a parent; a designated caregiver; homestay or temporary accommodation for groups students and short courses only.
- To involve the residential carer in the welfare of a student away from the student's family and home country.
- To assist the student to successfully integrate into the New Zealand lifestyle.
- To work towards the overseas parents' peace of mind knowing that the student is well cared for and happy in New Zealand.
