

International Student Policy

Rationale:

The purpose of this policy is to provide information and guidance to all to ensure the purpose and benefits for the enrolment of fee-paying international students are outlined. By enrolling international students, the school aims to promote internationalization, providing opportunities for students and staff from different cultures to work alongside each other in teaching and learning, providing different perspectives in order to develop each individual's understanding of other cultures. Our goal is for all our students to become connected global citizens, ready to live and work in the diverse and connected modern world.

International Student at any time, means a person who is not then a domestic student. Although deemed domestic, exchange students, students whose parents may be studying a PHD or on a work visa, and permanent residents who have recently arrived in this country, and whose level of English means they are not able to work independently in a classroom situation, may come under the umbrella of the International Department.

Guidelines:

- To promote international understanding and enhance the multi-cultural dimension of our school.
- To provide a supportive atmosphere and environment for international students both in the learning environment and the home situation.
- To provide quality education for international students with extra support, as appropriate, to enable them to achieve maximum academic success.
- International Students will be enrolled at Lincoln High School under a Contract of Enrolment in accordance with Section 2 of the Education Act 1989.
- Appropriate staff and resources will be allocated by the school for the recruitment, administration and pastoral care requirements of international students.
- To provide firm guidelines on matters of pastoral care for international students.
- To ensure provision of economic support for the school and its community.
- To recruit students actively by promoting Lincoln High School on the international market.
- Lincoln High School will be compliant with all aspects of The Education (Pastoral Care of Tertiary and International Learners) Code of Practice 2022.
